## Portland, Oregon – December 03, 2020 – Record Number of Contributions Yields \$525,000 in Grants from Ninety-Nine Girlfriends

Ninety-nine girlfriends, a women's collective giving circle recently celebrated the local nonprofits who received grants from the organization in 2020. Despite the COVID pandemic 505 women elected to pool their resources together to benefit our community. This is the largest number of women to participate in this 5-year experiment in collective action.

"Members spoke up to shape the 2020 grantmaking differently than in prior years. In 2020, the priority was to provide unrestricted grants, not project grants, and to get the funds out three months earlier than in the past." shared Holly Cook, Grants Steering Committee Co-Chair. She continued, "Applications across five focus areas (arts, health, family, environment, and education) were reviewed by member teams during the summer. Instead of making five \$100,000 grants, 10 nonprofits received \$50,000 grants and finalist groups each received \$5,000."

Tammy Wilhoite, her Co-Chair, explained, "Our goal for this year was to support nonprofits as they respond to the challenges created or exacerbated by the COVID-19 crisis, with special emphasis on efforts to benefit people affected by inequity due to discrimination or exclusion. Like other collective giving circles around the world, we continue to evolve the ways in which we connect with and support the diverse nonprofit community that does so much for our region.
